The Lacan Circle of Melbourne is pleased to announce the recommencement of its fortnightly seminars on fundamental texts in psychoanalysis. The text for this year is Jacques Lacan, *Seminar V, Formations of the Unconscious; Le séminaire, livre V, Formations de l'inconscient*: a bilingual reading of the text. This is the most significant of Lacan's early seminars and an excellent introduction to the key concepts of Lacanian psychoanalysis.

Close commentary will be accompanied by detailed discussion of crucial issues covering three major themes: linguistic workings of the unconscious, the graph of desire, and the paternal metaphor. The Lacanian field is inherently multidisciplinary and so these informal talks are open to all who share an interest in psychoanalysis.
